Sunday, July 6, 2008

3:00 p.m. Check-in at University Inn (Directions Below, Map attached)

Note: Exit 113, in the Interstate directions below, lies on a short stretch in Lexington where I-75 and I-64 run together.

From I-64 East/West and I-75 North/South: Take **Exit 113 (Paris/Lexington)** and turn **right** onto **North Broadway**.

Continue on North Broadway for approximately **five miles**, through downtown Lexington, and turn **left** onto **Waller Avenue** (as you approach Waller, you will see an **Arby's** restaurant on your **left**, and **St. Joseph Hospital** will be on the **corner of Waller Avenue**). Continue on **Waller**, through one light, across a set of **railroad tracks**, and approximately 500 feet past a second light. The **University Inn** will be on your **left just before the next light (Nicholasville Road)** -- take the **first parking lot entrance**.

From Bluegrass Airport: Turn **left** from the airport entrance onto **Man o' War**, and get into the **right lane**. Turn **right** at the **first light (Versailles Road)**. *******Get into the **center lane**. At the **fourth light past Man o' War**, turn **right** onto **Mason-Headley Road**. Continue on **Mason-Headley** which, at the first major intersection (**Harrodsburg Road**), **becomes Waller Avenue**. Cross **Harrodsburg Road (St. Joseph Hospital** will be on your **right**), through one light, across a set of **railroad tracks**, and approximately 500 feet past a second light. The **University Inn** will be on your **left just before the next light (Nicholasville Road)** -- take the **first parking lot entrance**.

From Bluegrass Parkway: At the **end of the Parkway**, veer **right** onto **Versailles Road**. Continue approximately **5 miles** toward Lexington through the **third light (Man o' War)**. Then proceed using the "**From Bluegrass Airport**" directions above (at *******).
